We are very excited to be able to offer to your student the opportunity to learn about and have practical experience in the field of firefighting, emergency services, and law enforcement.

Through a career development program called “Exploring” students have the chance to gain actual experience in various career fields. This “hands on” learning program is designed to bridge the gap between school and a possible future career.
