

## **SENIOR PROJECT SPRING 2017**

Senior Project is a credit-bearing course that provides an opportunity for students to showcase the knowledge, creativity, and skills developed as a result of their twelve years of education. Through the Senior Project experience, students focus on individual and special interests and are held accountable for their own learning.

\*\*Faculty/School Board members agreeing to serve as mentors must first sign the Faculty Agreement Form (Exhibit C). Individuals agreeing to serve as mentors are required to sign the Mentor Form (Exhibit B). All mentors must fill out the Off/On Campus Agreement (Exhibit A). Exhibit A must be filled out by the student, the student's parents and the Mentor they will be working with for the Semester.

**EXHIBIT A:**     Senior Project Agreement On/Off Campus Credit – this must be signed by **ALL** parties and turned in by **January 13, 2017**.

**EXHIBIT B:**     Senior Project Mentor Agreement – **THEY DO NOT WORK AT THE SCHOOLS** - this must be signed by the person/mentor you are volunteering for – turn in at the **2<sup>nd</sup> turn in**

**OR**

**EXHIBIT C:**     Senior Project Faculty/Sumner County Employee Agreement - this must be signed by the teacher or staff employed with **SUMNER COUNTY SCHOOLS** – turned in at the **2<sup>nd</sup> turn in**

**EXHIBIT D:**     Mentor Evaluation of Senior Project – signed by the person/mentor you are volunteering for – **ONLY ONE SHEET TURNED IN FOR EACH TURN IN**

**EXHIBIT E:**     SENIOR PROJECT TIME/JOURNAL SHEET - \*\*\*\*\*one for **EACH** week – signed by the person you are volunteering for/mentor - \*\*\*\*\***TOTAL THE HOURS FOR THAT WEEK** – some turn in dates will require 3, 4, 5 or 6 time sheets – depending on how many weeks between the dates. **THE JOURNAL SHOULD BE FILLED OUT – NOT JUST A FEW SENTENCES**

**EXHIBIT F:**     Student Evaluation of Senior Project – This will be turned in at the **LAST** turn in and also signed by the person you are volunteering for/mentor.

**EXHIBIT G:**     Summative Mentor Evaluation of Senior Project – This will be turned in at the **LAST** turn in and also signed by the person you are volunteering for/mentor.

On average, students will participate in Senior Project activities 6 hours per week. At the end of the semester, the student should have accumulated at least 105 hours. The academic or instructional activities may take place on or off the high school campus. Each senior may earn one elective credit per semester for successful completion of the course. The student will receive a Pass/Fail credit that will not be computed into the student's GPA, but will appear on the student's final transcript. **IF THE SENIOR FAILS TO MEET THE DEADLINE OF A TURN IN – THEY WILL HAVE FAILED SENIOR PROJECT.**
