Re: Graduation

Graduation is a somber, respectful, once in a life time occasion, which we at White House High School want to make an excellent experience for all. If the following stipulations are met, this can be accomplished.

1. **PROPER DRESS** – Graduation gowns are blue for ladies and gentleman.

GENTLEMEN – Dress Shirts (no polo shirt), Ties, Dark Pants or Dress Khakis, Dress Shoes. **(NO TENNIS SHOES, FLIP-FLOPS, or WORK BOOTS)**

LADIES Wear dress shoes. Dresses or dress pants/dress shirts should be worn underneath the blue gown. **(NO TENNIS SHOES, FLIP-FLOPS, OR WORK BOOTS)**

*****Bring the shoes you are wearing to graduation to graduation practice*****

If any student cannot afford graduation attire, please see Guidance by May 3rd.

NO DECORATIONS ON CAPS OR GOWNS WILL BE PERMITTED FOR ANYONE. THE ONLY CORDS, PINS, OR TASSELS ALLOWED ARE THE ONES PROVIDED BY WHHS.

2. **ARRIVE ON TIME**

Mandatory graduation practice will be **Thursday, May 16, 2019** at LHBC at **12:30 p.m.** **Bring your dress shoes to graduation practice!!!**

Graduation will be at **Long Hollow Baptist Church** at **7 p.m.** on **5/16/19.** **Seniors should be lined up by 6:30 p.m.**

3. **BEHAVIOR**

No alcohol and/or drugs of any kind will be allowed. If either is present the student in question will be pulled from the line and will not participate. There should be no talking among graduates during the ceremony.
